Hello Resident of Langhorne Borough,

We are pleased to inform you that we are making your curbside recycling program easier and more efficient. You have received this 64 gallon recycling cart at no cost to you. This cart should be used for single stream recycling, which means all recyclables can be placed into this cart without being separated or bagged.

On the reverse of this letter you will find a full list of recyclable items and non-recyclable items. Please keep these guidelines for future reference. Please do not place any trash in these carts, trash should continue to be placed in your existing trash cans only.

This easy to roll cart will be picked up with a fully automated truck which is more efficient and environmentally friendly. This truck has an automated arm which reaches out to grab and dump the cart so we ask that you please make every attempt to place your recycling cart at least 3 feet from all other objects like cars, mailboxes and trash containers. This is so the automated truck has enough space to access your container properly. Also, please place your cart curbside with the wheels facing your home.

Please note, if you move or relocate, this cart should not be removed from the property but should remain at the residence for the new homeowners as the cart is the property of Leck Waste Services. 


## Guide to Single Stream Recycling
