Holiday Pickups...

What if my pick-up falls on a holiday?

If Memorial Day, Labor Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Year's Day fall on a regular scheduled pick-up day, pick-up will be the following day.

Yard Waste...

When should I put out yard waste?

Yard waste is collected Wednesday with other waste each week of the year. Place yard waste in containers no larger than 32 gallons or in brown paper bags - no plastic bags please. Acceptable yard waste includes: branches up to 3 inches in diameter and no longer than 4 feet long and Christmas trees. Please note Christmas Tree Pickup will be Wednesday January 10th & 17th, 2024. Please do not put Christmas Trees in a bag.

Quick Reference Guide to Waste Removal Services

When should trash be placed at the curb?

All waste is picked up every Wednesday. Place trash, recyclables, yard waste and bulk items out after 6:00 PM on Tuesday evening. Place containers so they are not blocked by vehicles or other large objects.

What size container should I use?

Containers should be between 20 and 35 gallons and should not exceed 50 pounds per container. Use sturdy plastic or metal containers with handles and detachable lids.

How do I dispose of leftover paint?

Evaporate latex paint by air-drying or mixing with kitty litter, shredded newspaper or other absorbent. Please place at the curb with the lid off so the driver is able to see that the paint is dry.

Items not acceptable?

We do not accept liquid waste of any kind, tree stumps or tires. We do not accept Household Hazardous Waste of any kind including insecticides, pesticides, gasoline, oil, non-latex paints, varnish, thinners, drain cleaner, pool chemicals, car parts or similar materials as part of your regular waste removal services. Hold all HHW materials for special collection events.

Bulk Items...

When are bulk items collected?

Collection of larger items is on Wednesday with your trash and recycling service.

What type of bulk items are collected?

Examples of regular bulk items include furniture, cabinets, washers and dryers.

How much can I discard at once?

The limit is one bulk item per week.

What about refrigerators?

All freon items such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers containing CFC's, require an appointment. To make an appointment, email admin@georgeleckandson.com or call 215-675-8000.

Recyclables...

When should I put my recycling out?

Recyclables should be placed in a recycling bin clearly labeled as "Recyclables" and placed at the curb for collection each Wednesday. Recycling labels are available free of charge at Langhorne Borough Hall.

Recycle weekly with Single Stream Recycling!

All recycling is single stream, meaning you can put all of your recyclables together in one recycling container, including glass, mixed paper, cardboard and plastic.

What can I recycle?

Glass, Metal: tin and aluminum.

Mixed Paper: newspaper, magazines, junk
mail, soft-back books, cartons.

Plastic: containers & most mixed plastics.

Cardboard: emptied and flattened.

What items are not recyclable?

Metal: aluminum foil, pots and pans.

Glass: Light bulbs, windows.

Paper: hard-back books, tissues, food-

soiled paper.

Plastic: Styrofoam, plastic bags.

Other: chemicals, rubber, wood, ceramic

or porcelain.
